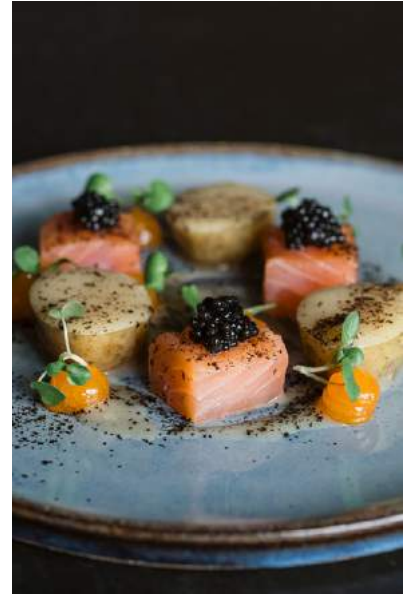

## **COST**

### **June - September**

Minimum Spend - Weekend (Fri-Sun) £18,000 | Weekday (Mon-Thu) £14,000

### **October - May**

Minimum Spend - Weekend (Fri-Sun) £12,500 | Weekday (Mon-Thu) £10,000

This is inclusive of a £2500 venue hire fee.

## **DEPOSIT**

50% of minimum spend paid on confirmation of booking, refundable up to 4 weeks prior to the booking date. 50% balance to be paid 4 weeks before the booking date (non-refundable). Extras are to be settled on the day.
